When Should My Child Stay Home Sick?

We are having a rough winter of illness and you can help us keep all kids healthier by keeping your child home when they are sick or recovering from their illness. We do have students who have lowered immune states also, and we work really hard to protect them from illnesses.

Please follow these guidelines and if you have any questions, PLEASE call one of the nurses, and PLEASE understand when we have to call you to take your child home sick.

***STAY HOME UNTIL FEVER FREE FOR 24 HOURS.** This means a temp of less than 100 without any fever reducing medications for a full day. This is especially important in the influenza season to make sure that they have had enough rest and fluid, and that their bodies are ready to come back for a whole day of school.

***STAY HOME IF YOU HAVE DIARRHEA OR THROW UP.** If you have these symptoms, you should stay home that day and the next day to ensure that the symptoms don’t return, and that they have again had enough rest and fluid to stay at school. The germs that cause these symptoms are also easily spread.

***STAY HOME IF YOU HAVE A BAD COUGH.** If your child has a very bad cough and it is not controlled, they should stay home. Although we all work very hard at the “Cover Your Cough” habit, if they are coughing frequently, or coughing up frequent phlegm, they should stay home and may need to see their provider. The same goes for really running noses. It is tough to play if you are wiping your nose every couple minutes, and worse if your teacher has to stop to help you.

Make plans for days when your children are ill, and if you are not available to come get them. Please have a backup person that you can call that can come get them if they are sick at school. If we can’t reach you, we will phone your emergency contacts to either get ahold of you, or to pick up your child. The most important way we can all stay well is washing our hands. Wash them often, and wash well with soap and water. Thank you for your part in helping keep all of Armstrong healthy!
