Beginning December 7th, the following sites will be open:

1. Lake Middle School – Tuesday morning from 9am-noon
2. Woodbury Middle School – Wednesday morning from 9am-noon
3. Oltman Middle School – Wednesday afternoon from noon-3:00pm
4. Woodbury High School – Thursday evening from 4:00-7:00pm
5. East Ridge High School – Friday morning from 9am-noon
6. Park High School – Friday morning from 9am –noon

Each site will be providing 5 breakfasts and 5 lunches along with milk for each student.
